The class hopes he comes back again for another






#### MRS. KOON'S CLASS OF INVENTORS



Her 2nd grade class is learning about health and the importance of keeping their teeth healthy too. With the right foods, eveyone can have a cute smile!












#### **6TH GRADE SCIENCE**








#### 8TH GRADE SCIENCE














#### **CONGRATULATIONS KENNEDY**
