I love to do things outdoors, but one of my favorites is kayaking. It is fun to bring my dog, Nala, along too!

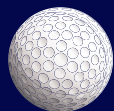
Where is your favorite place to vacation?

Definitely Universal Studios in Orlando! My favorite ride is Hagrid's Motorbike Adventure!

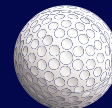
