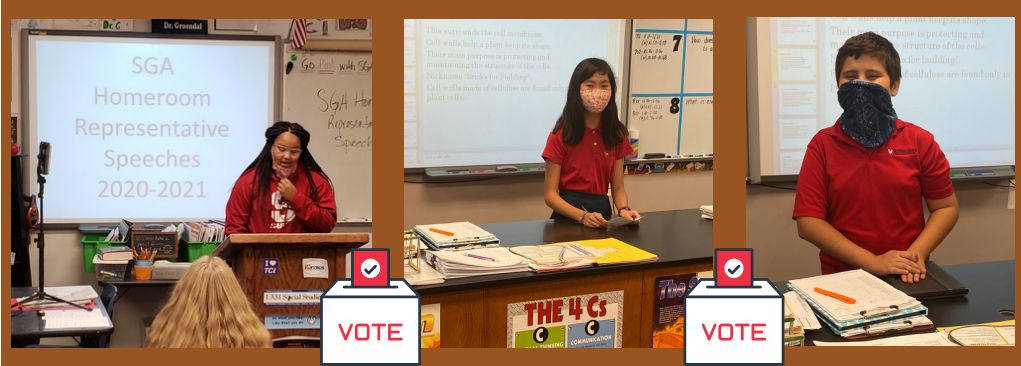

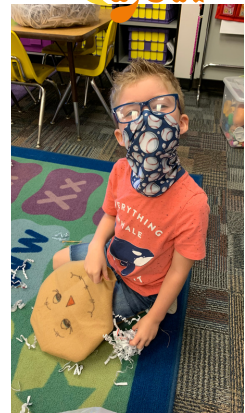

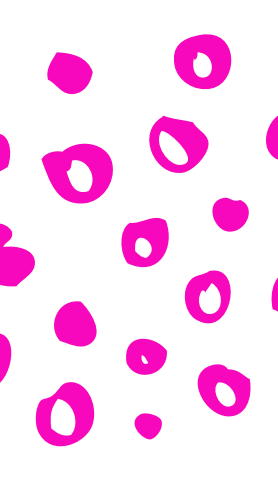
Second graders had a blast carving their pumpkin, removing the seeds and then lighting it up for a group picture!

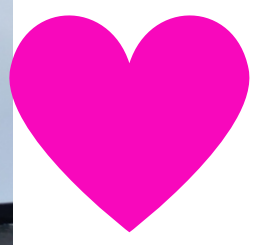
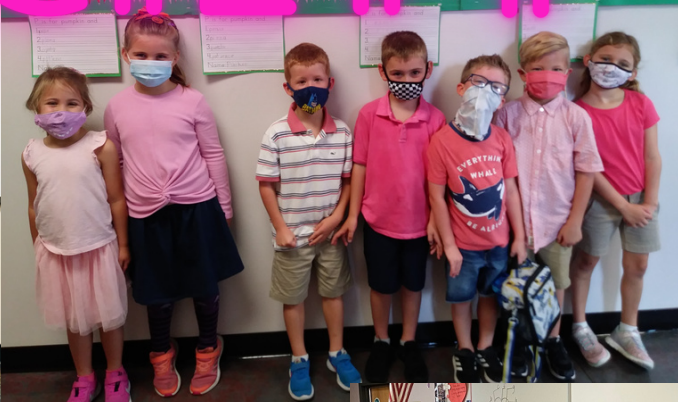
Students in 3rd Grade created a pumpkin to represent a character in one of their favorite books. We have some creative students in 3rd Grade!

Kind Mouse supports families that are homeless and in transition. Listed are specific items that are needed. Together, we can make an impact in our local community.



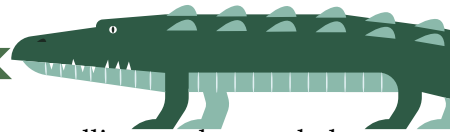
