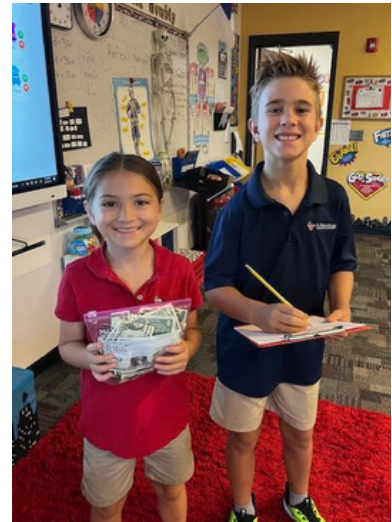
SAFETY FIRST

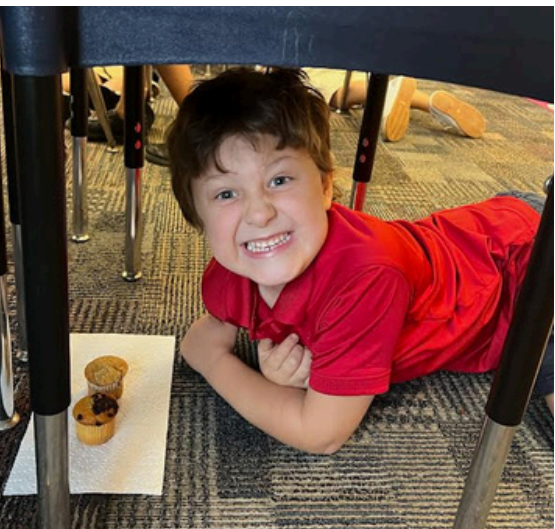
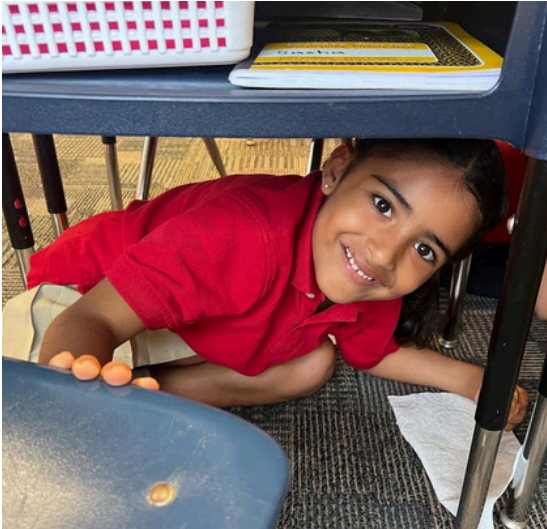
3RD GRADE POPCORN PROJECT

1ST GRADE COMMUNITY HELPERS

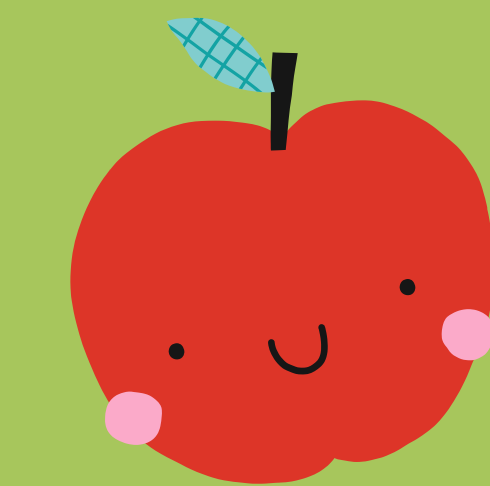

Miss Dorsett's class made a fun craft with fall leaves. Their cute little hedgehogs are ready for the cooler weather!

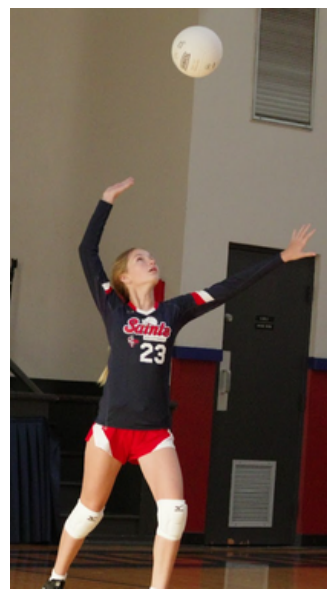
